## TLSF's Navi4Health at the 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Texas Breast Cancer Collaborative Meeting

Austin, TX (October 25, 2010) Texas Life Science Foundation's (TLSF) Navi4Health clinical trial and care case management is the subject of a peer-reviewed poster session at the 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Breast Health Summit in Houston, October 27-28<sup>th</sup>. The poster, presented in the Education and Outreach section, provides data from the recently completed Dia de la Mujer Latina (DML) Promotora de Salud training project which was supported through a grant from Blue Cross Blue Shield of Texas. TLSF's Navi4Health was selected by DML to provide case management for over 1200 Latina participants in the project. Participant demographics, barriers to care, cancer screening and survivorship information were captured by the Promotoras using Navi4Health's online systems. Additionally the Promotora time and resources allocated to navigate participants to care continues to be tracked using Navi4Health. DML provided training and Texas-state certification to 160 Promotores/as de Salud and Community Health Workers in this project.
